YOUR CONCERT ASSOCIATION RETURNS TO THE STAGE IN SEPTEMBER AND WE HOPE YOU DO TOO!

After a one-year delay, we are offering our biggest **(SEVEN CONCERTS!)** season ever.

This 84th season “Celebrating our Greatest Generation” is dedicated to longtime supporters and members of the WCCA Board of Directors, Sarah Zimmerman and Dick Shook. It will be great to see you back in the seats again – and current Pennsylvania rules permit our full membership to attend in the 1500-seat high school auditorium. We will once again honor military members at a fall concert, and first responders and educators in the spring.

In four seasons, from the 2016 to 2019 subscription campaigns, membership grew more than 50%, to well over 500. For the spring 2020 campaign supporting the 84th season (then scheduled to open in September 2020), more than 300 members subscribed before we chose to postpone the season. We are excited about the program for this delayed season and hoping to welcome back the other 200 or so members who held off last year.
